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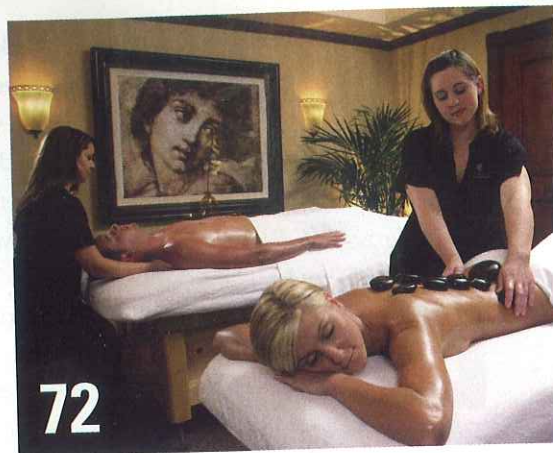
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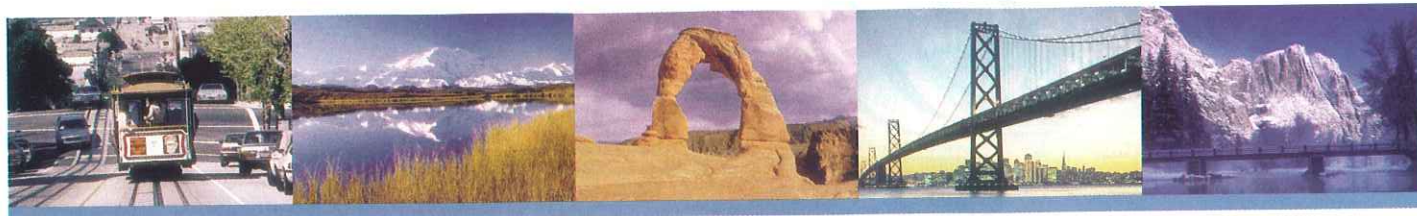

The fervor Harris-Jackson possesses about what she does came about when she was in high school. She styled hair, nails and make-up on a freelance basis and she fell in love with the ability to make



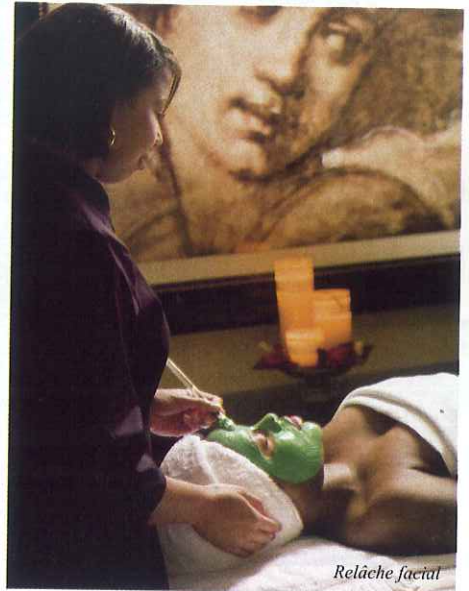

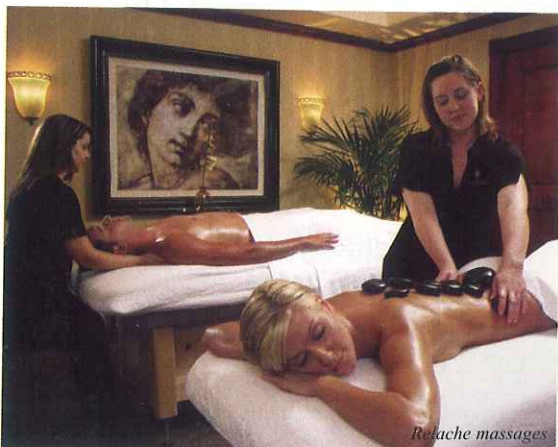
